- List locations if not really well known; applying for something not local; or not obvious from title.
- Try to keep it to one page; therefore list most significant accomplishments only.
- Be sure to get all names of competitions, etc correct. Also accurately list the name of your award.
- Be consistent with your formatting and use of punctuation.
